

BENSTEAD CUP — awarded for riding Club Events

NON-COMPETITIVE CLUB EVENTS

- Bicycle Icycle
- 50 mile Reliability Ride
- Stonehenge 200 **or** Danebury 150 **or** Elstead 100 km
- Tour of the Hills **or** Tour of the Greensand Hills
- 100 **or** 75 **or** 50 mile Reliability Ride

Completing any of these within the maximum time allowed **50 points**
Or, Starting any non-competitive Club event **20 points**
Maximum of **200 points** per year

COMPETITIVE CLUB EVENTS

- Pace Judging
- Freewheeling

Event winner: **100 points**

Other placings: $100(1-[P-1]/N)$ where P = position, N = no. of entrants.

e.g. for 20 entries: 1st = 100 points, 2nd = 95 points, 3rd = 90 points etc.

Competitive events only count if there are at least 4 entrants.

ATTENDANCE ON CLUB RUNS

Sundays maximum of **4 points**

Morning start = 1 point, mid-morning break = 1 point

lunch = 1 point, afternoon tea = 1 point

Midweek

3 points

These points will determine people's **places** in the Benstead Cup attendance competition, which will be scored in the same way as a competitive club event (above), except that if there are more than 100 people in the attendance competition then the number of entrants, N, will be taken to be 100 and people placed lower than 100th will score 0.
